#### **ADOPTION success stories**


A lot of the dogs that come to BAWCS have been surrendered because their previous owners can't manage them anymore.

A dog's behaviour is usually a reflection of what it is NOT getting, whether it be exercise, attention, stimulation or just the company of another.

Each dog that comes to BAWCS is assessed and placed into an appropriate foster carer home. This gives us an opportunity to observe the behaviour and also work on correcting any issues that present with our Animal Behaviourist and Dog Training Mark Murray being involved. Frankie was a classic case of one crazy mixed up dog that BAWCS rehomed a number of times, each time thinking it was the right home, making sure the new owners were well equipped to take him on after he'd undergone assessment and training with Mark. Frankie's last placement was with a different foster care home to the previous one he'd had and we are now delighted to report now this is now his permanent home! Thanks to the dedication of the carer and her family, thanks to the tips from Mark and thanks to Frankie doing more 'hard yards'... the work has paid off and another life that most probably would have been snuffed out had he ended up in the wrong shelter, has been saved.


