Last year we applied for State Government funding via the **Animal Welfare Fund Grants** and were successful in receiving a large grant to assist us with expanding the Shelter with a new 'vet' building. The building will allow us to have a vet visit us on a weekly basis to attend to our animals in need rather than transporting them which will alleviate any undue stress, in particular our cats.

It will also free up our valued volunteers to spend more time at the shelter caring for our animals rather than driving back and forth to the vet.


As part of our Community Support, BAWCS will now be able to offer discounted desexing, vaccination and microchipping on site to disadvantaged pet owners as part of our pro active approach to responsible pet ownership support.

We thank the City of Greater Bendigo, Jacinta Allan MP, Lisa Chesters MP and McIvor Road Veterinary Centre for their support for our application and of course the State Government for making the funding available.

At time of writing, we had just started our new Project with the concrete slab being prepared.


#### **New arrival Gem**
